Instructions

Dear Kelsey - Patches did very well for her ultrasound this morning. She was given a diuretic injection (to enhance visualizing her bladder) so for the next 6-8 hours she may need to drink and urinate more. The ultrasound showed changes/irregularities to both her bladder and her liver. The bladder shows a thickened irregular mass, most likely consistent with a malignant cancer called Transitional Cell carcinoma. The liver changes may be aging/hepatopathy changes, but it is concerning this may be metastasis (spread of the bladder cancer) to the liver. There are options of oral medications, chemotherapy and possibly surgical resection to consider - I would recommend consulting with Dr Jason Kidd at San Francisco Veterinary Specialistis, or Dr Kathy Andres at the AMISS group. Both are very good, knowledgeable and friendly oncologists. The urine culture was negative, so you do not have to continue giving the Zeniquin antibiotic.
